

## Resident Spotlight - Clarence Sinnette

Clarence Sinnette celebrated his 100th birthday on November 18th. Clarence was born in the coal mining community of Vivian, WV, and until the family moved to Huntington, spent most of his life in the West Virginia mining areas. He attended grade school at Holden, South Charleston, and Ashland, Kentucky where he graduated.

He began working in 1929 as a second class clerk for the C&O Railway Company. After losing his job during the depression in 1932, he was hired as clerk in the Island Creek Store at Holden that same year. Remaining in the coal industry for the next 49 years, he became secretary-treasurer for the Princess Coals group, financial vice-president of Princess Coal Sales and Sycamore Coal Company, president and chief executive officer of Green Brook Coal Company, and owner of Universal Fuel Sales. He retired in 1981 after a career of 52 years.



Clarence has been President of the Powellton Chapter of the National Association of Foremen, The Triadelphia Country Club, The Man Rotary Club, The Ohio Valley Accountants Association, and chairman of the Triadelphia Youth Center. He worked with the Boy Scouts of America for 20 years serving as scoutmaster, cubmaster and district commissioner.

His two long-time hobbies have been tennis and photography. Clarence has competed in many tennis tournaments on the national level where he won 3 gold medals, 2 silver medals and 1 bronze medal. One of the most memorable was when he won a gold medal at the Nation Senior Games in Tucson, Arizona in 1997.


