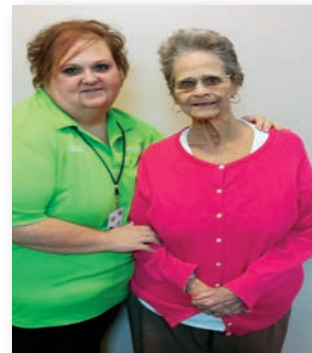


Mother's Day Luncheon
